For more than 30 years, the Tri CYA has provided a broad range of educational, developmental, social and recreational programs, in addition to providing counseling and advocacy.

Children who attend quality afterschool programs have better school grades, peer relations, emotional adjustment and conduct than their peers who are left unsupervised after school.

Our ‘Drop In’ Centers

Open to all local youth, Tri CYA runs three individual ‘Drop In’ centers: Huntington, South Huntington, and Cold Spring Harbor. The ‘Drop In’ centers are filled with fun and safe activities - a great place to hang out with friends. Some of the **Recreational Programs** include: Basketball, Yoga, Karate, Swimming, Bowling, and more.

Tri CYA is also very focused on developing leadership skills, and we offer an array of programs designed to help our youth reach their greatest potential. **Youth Development Programs** include: Mentoring, Natural Helpers, Peer Mediation, Youth Council, and more.

To support and compliment the goals of our local school districts, we offer **Educational Programs** daily: Homework Help, Computer Skills, Math Wizards, Reading Programs, and more.

And when school is out for the summer and the weather gets hot, we provide **Summer Field Trips**: Robert Moses Beach, pools, movies, parks, and educational and cultural trips.

Finally, Tri CYA is involved in the lives of the people who live in our community. We provide support to individuals and families and help them identify all the available resources the Town of Huntington has to offer. Some of our **Community Programs** include: Nutrition Empowerment and Wellness (N.E.W.), Communities and Schools Together (C.A.S.T.), and Treasure Our Youth (Project T.O.Y.)
