

#### PROGRAM PURPOSE

To strengthen and enrich family life through the provision of programs for children and adults. Activities are developed and implemented with the full participation of the community to respond to their needs.

#### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

**COMMUNITY SERVICES**-Include local specialized events and programs that meet community needs and provide families with enriching experiences.

SERVICES FOR YOUNG CHILDREN- Include programs aimed to strengthening the development of children up to age five through the provision of homebased early intervention and the Lockwood Preschool Learning Centers.

SUPPORT SERVICES-Include programs and services that assist families in stabilizing their lives. These are provided by bilingual staff trained in the areas of case management, advocacy, information and referral, crisis intervention, short-term counseling and housing assistance.

**VOCATIONAL SERVICES**-Include vocational counseling, job readiness training, job placement assistance and career guidance services through the WorkPlus Program.
